
















NO THANK YOU ITEMS

ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT

Due to safety concerns/risks, the following items are not accepted at any JBF Sales.



Homemade Masks

Due to safety risks and concerns, only factory-sealed masks or face coverings can be sold at JBF sales.



Incline Sleepers

Due to risk posed to infants, incline sleepers can no longer be accepted at Just Between Friends sales. A notice was provided by the CPSC on November 11, 2018 in which these sleepers were deemed unsafe after repeated incidents of infant suffocation.



Cribs made before June 28, 2011

All Cribs made before June 28, 2011 are no longer considered safe for infants—that includes all dropside cribs as they pose significant risks to infants. They cannot be sold or donated.

For cribs manufactured on or after June 28, 2011, a completed **Crib Waiver** is Required.



Crib Bumpers

All types of Crib Bumpers are no longer considered safe for cribs. These will not be accepted or sold at Just Between Friends Sales.
